How will I get there?



- Arrive at School 7:30am
- Luggage to be clearly labelled and brought into hall. One suitcase, a small bag for coach.
- Register with Miss Woodward/Miss Bright and give pocket money to Mrs Slaughter/Miss Teager (bagged and labelled in new style pound coins. For fairness, a maximum of £10)
- Medicine to Mrs Holdsworth (bagged and labelled with instructions)
- Coach will arrive in time for a prompt 8:00am departure





How will I get there

- You must bring a packed lunch and a drink - no chocolate or fizzy drinks. Make sure this is in your hand luggage not in your suitcase.
- Ferry crossing will be at 12.20
- Crossing approximately 1 hour - lunch will be eaten on the ferry.
- Coach to Little Canada

How will I get there?



- Sweets allowed for the journey
- Books/magazines etc for the journey
- No electronic games, mobile phones, MP3s etc allowed. If brought, will be taken by member of staff and given back to parents on our return.

What do I need to bring?

- Your parents have a clothing list.
- Only disposable cameras - clearly labelled. Don't worry if you don't have a camera. Staff will have a school camera each and will take lots of photos. You can then buy a DVD of the photos after the trip.
- **Waterproof jacket, long sleeves and long trousers ESSENTIAL**
- No new clothes - very muddy!
- Please note, no disco this year
- Ensure all clothes and belongings are clearly labelled!
- Water bottles
- Book
- You must be able to wheel/carry your own suitcase

How can I keep in touch with my family?

- The school will send Groupcall texts to your family every day.
- Twitter - we will post updates via our school Twitter feed (@GiffardsPrimary).
- You can buy a postcard in the shop and send it home - make sure you bring stamps and the address.

Where will I sleep?

- Girl only/ boy only chalets
- Up to 6 in a chalet.
- Beds/bunk beds
- Chalets close together in our own group
- Teacher chalets next to/opposite children's
- Chalets have showers and toilets
- Have to be kept tidy by children and will be inspected

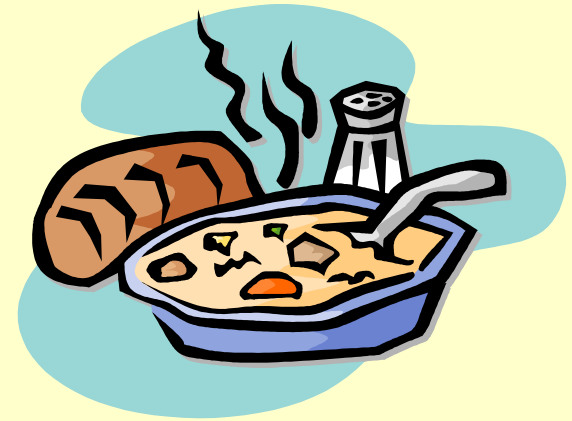


Where will I sleep?

- Make own beds!
- Keys will be **your** responsibility - lost keys will have to be paid for among the cabin - £5
- You will select 3 people who you would like to share with. You will be guaranteed to be with at least one person you have selected
- Won't find out who you are sharing with until arrival

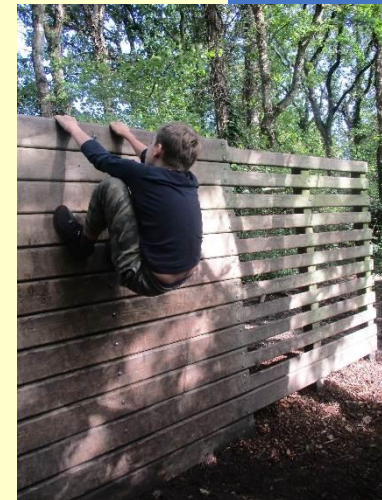
What will I eat?

- Wide choice, including vegetarian options
- Allocated seats and meal times
- Breakfast - cooked, toast, cereal, fruit
- Bread and fruit always available at lunch and dinner
- Encouraged to try foods you may not have had at home!



What will I do?

- High wire activities, climbing, abseiling, archery, team games, problem solving.....
- There will be a mixture of individual and team building activities
- Won't know exact activities until nearer departure

What happens on the last day?



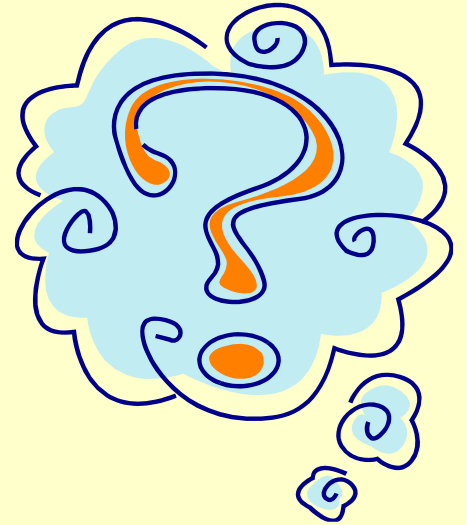
- Morning activity
